## **Become a Trustee of the Mosquito District!**

One trustee position is available for the current term of the Mosquito and Vector Management District of Santa Barbara County Board of Trustees beginning January 2016. Term duration is at the discretion of the appointing body, but is generally two years. The vacancy is for a seat to be occupied by a resident at large of the County of Santa Barbara.

The Board meets once a month on the second Thursday at Hope School in Santa Barbara. Meetings are about two hours long. A monthly \$100 stipend to defray expenses is provided to each trustee. An additional budget is available for trustees to travel to certain training events.

Trustees are requested to be knowledgeable about fiscal and personnel management and about, or willing to learn about, mosquitoes, mosquito-borne diseases, and other vectors and vector-borne diseases. A primary function of the Board of Trustees is to establish policy and making decisions as guidelines for administrative execution. An important annual goal of the board is to help prepare and determine the District's budget.

The Board acts as a whole for the good of the entire district. No single trustee is allowed to make individual decisions for the District. All activities of the Board are governed by the Brown Act – Open Meetings Law. The Board is comprised of eight trustees – five are appointed by the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors and three are each appointed by the city councils of the cities of Goleta, Santa Barbara and Carpinteria.
